Our Integrity Management Program was developed to ensure the integrity of natural gas transmission pipelines and to comply with the requirements of the U.S. Department of Transportation §49 CFR Part 192, Subpart O – Gas Transmission Pipeline Integrity Management (TRIMP).

TRIMP

Our TRIMP includes proactive prevention of transmission pipeline failures, with a focus on High Consequence Areas (locations along the pipeline with high population density and places where people congregate, such as schools, hospitals, parks, and churches). This is achieved through:



ANALYSIS & ASSESSMENT

- Risk modeling
- In-line inspections
- Pressure testing
- Direct assessment



PREVENTION MEASURES

- Extra patrols along the pipeline
- Additional leak surveys
- Remote control valve installation
- Emergency response drills



DAMAGE PREVENTION

- Safe excavation practices
- High-pressure standby
- One-call programs
- Excavator training
